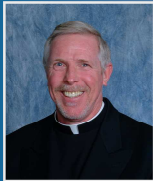

Seminar Speakers



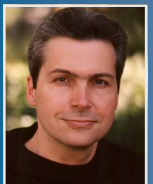
Fr. Richard Benson, C.M.
