

## **SOHLNET Sanctity of Human Life Week Prayer and Proclamation for Life Events - Jan. 12-17, 2009**

*“Have nothing to do with the fruitless deeds of darkness, rather expose them.” Ephesians 5:11*

*We will be praying that the abortionists who we will identify at these locations will cease doing abortions, repent and be converted to Christ.*

**Bud's Note:** Although we are confronting those who shed innocent blood (Isa 1: 16-20) we will be doing it in a Christ like manner. I wrote letters to each of the four doctors who we will be identifying at their regular OBGYN practices. I asked for private meetings with them at locations of their choice. I explained that I would ask them to discontinue their abortion practices. None of them responded.

We will be publicly identifying by name the four different doctors who work together to provide abortions in the Sacramento area. We plan to continue our presence at their locations throughout the year, praying they will end their abortion practices. Abortion doctors who have legitimate OBGYN practices do NOT want the general public to know they kill unborn babies. None of these doctors advertise their abortion practices. In most cases they are ashamed of their sin of baby killing. Our hope is that as we bring their dark deeds into the light, they will repent, as many former abortion doctors and providers have, and end their shedding of innocent blood.

All attending our events will be asked to follow the example and directions of Sohlnet leadership. We will be using signage, including graphic abortion pictures that are the evidence of the dark deeds of these doctors. Please consider participating and pray for the doctors to repent. I am not posting their names on the net or e-mail at this time as I am hopeful they will respond to our prayer and proclamation as outlined below.
